Gladys Quabla is the Sr. Library Assistant at a Central University College in Accra. CUC has over 5,000 students with 4 fields of study, the newest school is opening in October, the College of Applied Science. African Hope donated 5,000 Medical/Science books to the CUC Library to assist in this new field of study. During this process it was also discovered that Gladys had a dream of collecting and distributing books in Ghana. She had already applied for her NGO status (Non Profit Org) and had purchased land for this endeavor. She knew that there were those in Ghana that had books and educational items going unused in their home or educational facility. She wanted to collect them and redistribute them to others who are in need. On March 26, 2007 she was blessed with 5,000+ books and has begun to bless those in Ghana with a need for books.

Wells of Hope

Can you imagine making this decision?

Each morning and afternoon you go to the area where you can fetch water for the family. You can pull buckets of water up from an open well that is about 30 ft. deep. This water has a slight saltiness to it because you are in a fishing village and are only 2 kilometers from the sea. It also has bugs in it that need pulled out, most are mosquito larvae. As you pull up the bucket it bounces off the stones on the inside of the well, just a bit of sand, dirt and mold/moss get into your bucket...no big deal. Maybe today I will use the water pump that is very close to the open well. The water is crystal clear, there are no bugs and it is not contaminated. This water comes from a deep hole, but it is very salty and you cannot drink it. What would you do? Which would you choose? Many decide to pull water from the swamp or from the near by ponds because it has no salt. Sadly many will die from this decision; most of them will be under the age of 5 years old.

This scenario ends in Gomoa Fetteh!! African Hope has successfully bored a fresh water well in the area of the other salt wells. This well will provide water for a complete village and to the Village of Hope Orphanage. We appreciate all who have donated towards this project and are happy to announce that it has been successfully completed.

As a Mother and an RN it has been an extreme emotional drain for Kim to see so many children with medical/surgical needs that cannot be corrected here in West Africa. African Hope has been fortunate to have found a partner agency in

Ohio that will assist us in correcting these children in dire need of medical attention. Once we have located a special needs child we then procure a birth certificate, passport and USA visa (not an easy task). Then Kim escorts the child to the USA where a foster family is waiting to love and care for them, take them to the Doctor/hospital and to assist in all that is needed to ensure their rehabilitation. Then the healed child is returned to their family in Ghana. Just now there is a very small 5 year old girl named Bernice who has gone for correcting of two club feet. This process may take up to one year and will require her to learn to walk again (correctly). This abnormality is a birth defect and no one in Ghana has the expertise to correct it. Even if the expertise was in West Africa it would not be affordable to 95% of the population. Bernice will return with us after our time of ministry in the USA. When we return Bernice to her village it will be a day of great celebration. Bernice lived with her Grandmother who is a JuJu Priest (Ancient African Religion). This evil woman rules the village with fear and intimidation; telling everyone she will curse them just as she has cursed her grand daughter. These lies will be broken and truth will come to this village when a "healed" Bernice returns to her village. We will have a victory celebration and an open air revival, asking all who are present to see the lies of this evil woman and to break free from their bondage of fear. Don't you want to come and see what happens on this day?
